**Directions:** From I-95, take Exit 49 (Darien). Turn west onto GA 251. Go 2.9 miles and turn left toward Cox at the fork, leaving GA 251. Proceed 5.7 miles, cross over former railroad tracks (sign on right) and turn left onto the first dirt road. Go 2.9 miles to fork in the road. Go left to Barrington County Park. Signs for the event will be posted along the route.
