

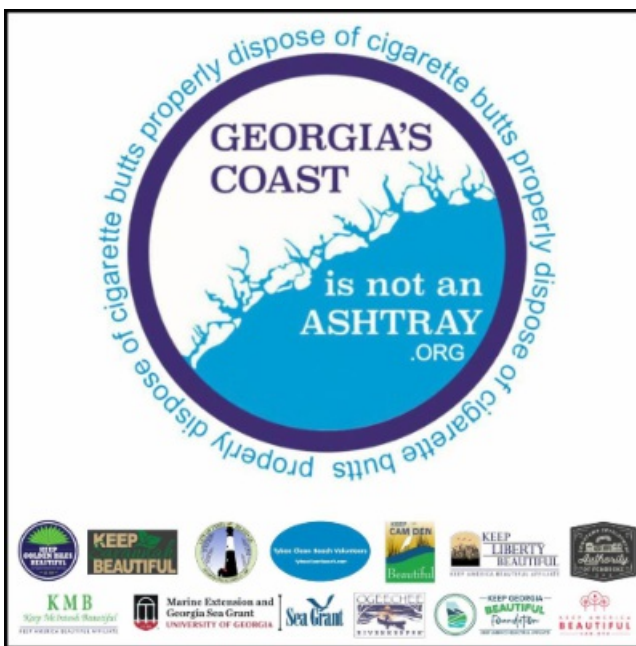

Georgia's Coast Is Not An Ashtray!

For the third straight summer, the regional cigarette litter prevention program, GEORGIA'S COAST IS NOT AN ASHTRAY, rolls into all six of the Peach State's coastal counties. Targeting cigarette litter as it relates to coastal waterways, project partners use inventive outreach and education methods to reach target markets. Visiting fishing piers, boat ramps and public space gathering areas with messaged t-shirts and stickers, distributing 30,000 messaged drink coasters at local pubs and restaurants and installing 100+ cigarette receptacles in public spaces near water bodies are all part of this summer's effort.

Cigarette butts are the nation's number one most littered item. Made of cellulose acetate, a type of plastic, they do not easily biodegrade. In waterways and water bodies, cigarette butts become toxic litter and endanger coastal habitats and their inhabitants. Properly disposing of cigarette butts is key.
